Divorce & Remarriage - "As It Was In The Beginning"

Introduction:

- A. Genesis 1:24-31 the sixth day of God's creation.
- B. Genesis 2:7-8, 18-25 provides further details.

I. A Closer Look At Genesis 2:24

- A. "For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother..."
 - 1. *Matthew 19:4-5* provides the additional reinforcement of God's Son.
 - 2. The husband-wife relationship takes precedence over all other human relationships.
- B. "...and be joined to his wife..."
 - 1. *Matthew 19:6* contains helpful commentary on the part of Jesus.
 - 2. Marriage is not just a human undertaking, but a divine action as well.
- C. "...and they shall become one flesh."
 - 1. Involves the physical relationship rightfully existing within marriage (Genesis 2:25).
 - 2. But not limited just to the physical contact of a husband and wife (Genesis 2:18).

II. Biblical Quotations Building On The Foundation Of Genesis 2:24

- A. *Malachi 2:11-16* the sad state of God's people when they ignored God's law.
 - 1. Deuteronomy 7:3
 - 2. Exodus 34:12-16
- B. *Matthew* 19:3-6 Jesus is asked about the legality of divorce.
 - 1. He goes back to *Genesis 1:27* and 2:24 and emphasizes God's original intention.
 - 2. "What God has joined together, let not man separate."
- C. *Ephesians* 5:22-33 Paul illustrates using the marriage relationship as God intended.

III. The Biblical Concept Of The Bond

- A. Not just two, but *three* parties are involved in a marriage God, a man, and a woman.
- B. The bond is a covenant with God that joins a husband and wife.
- C. God takes covenants seriously!
 - 1. Exodus 19:5-6.8
 - 2. How long does He intend for that bond to last? Romans 7:2; 1 Cor. 7:39
- D. Two fundamental principles God hates divorce. Why? Divorce always involves sin!
