"P...Pre...Premill..." What Is That Big Word, Anyway?

Scripture Reading — Revelation 20:1-6

Introduction:

- A. Most everyone would like to have some insight into the future.
- B. Many get extremely excited when they hear the Bible used to predict what the future holds.

I. What Is "Premillennialism"?

- A. "Pre" (before) and "millennium" (a period of 1,000 years)
- B. Premillennialism = the return of Jesus will occur before a special 1,000 year period
- C. The historical rise of Premillennialism.

II. Major Points of Premillennialism

- A. God promised an earthly kingdom with Jesus on David's throne.
- B. Jesus originally came to establish an earthly kingdom, but was rejected by the Jews.
- C. Jesus set up the church as a substitute (a "parenthesis").
- D. Jesus is King by right, but is not now actually on His throne.
- E. In order for Biblical prophecy to be fulfilled, a great world empire must be rebuilt with a world dictator over a 10-part kingdom.
- F. The Jews must be restored as a nation to Palestine.
- G. The Temple will be rebuilt in Jerusalem.
- H. Jesus will come **for** His saints in the Rapture and will come **with** His saints after 7 years.
- I. During those 7 years, those who were "left behind" on the earth will endure terrible tribulation.
- J. When Jesus comes with His saints after 7 years, the Battle of Armageddon will be fought and Jesus will reign on David's throne for 1,000 years.
- K. There will be three resurrections (at the Rapture, after the Tribulation, after the 1,000 years).
