3.	We are Bound by an Truth a. Mankind continually alters and updates their belief system, based on changes in culture or society b. God does not change. Consider His life (Jer.10:10, Psalm 90:2), His character (James 1:17, Mal. 3:6) His truth (Isa.40:6-8, Heb. 4:12)
4.	We realize that we are here. a. Accept the challenge to live showing that this world is not your permanent home. (1 Pet. 2:11, 2 Cor.5:8) b. Remember where you are headed, long for the day it comes. (Phil. 3:20-21; 1:21-23) There is glory to come (Rom. 8:18)

As we think about how we can live differently, how we can honor our Creator and be set apart for His glory, let's give our best to understand all that God has shown us in His word to help us.
