Recognizing and Defending Against the Flaming Darts of Temptation

- A. Ephesians 6:16 describes "the flaming darts of the evil one." His identity is clear (Rev 12:9).
 - 1. "Flaming" is a very appropriate way to describe the evil one's darts in light of James 3:5-6.
 - 2. Temptation is dissected in very personal times in *James 1:13-15*.
- B. These lures and enticements are as old as Genesis 3.

Conclusion:

- A. You inhabit a world at war and the battlefield in which you are engaged is your heart (2 Cor 10:3-5).
- B. Whomever you are, you are presenting yourself to someone as an obedient slave (*Rom 6:16*).
