

# “Wisdom is Justified by All Her Children”

A. In *Luke 7:24-30* we see two distinct paths, with Jesus as the fork in the road.

1. **Path #1:** those who had \_\_\_\_\_ to the purpose of God for themselves.

  - a. What are they like (*7:31-34*)? Like foolish children.
  - b. “*Yet wisdom is justified by all her children*” (*7:35*).
