3. WE NEED TO PRESERVE NEW TESTAMENT CHRISTIANITY

- 1. In the New Testament we see fasting done individually and as the church together.
 - Jesus fasted (Matthew 4:2).
 - Jesus said His disciples would fast after He returned to heaven (Matthew 9:15).
 - Jesus gave instructions for fasting (Matthew 6:16-18).
 - The church fasted and prayed before sending those out to preach the Good News (Acts 13:3).
 - The church fasted and prayed when appointing elders (Acts 14:23).

"But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not be seen by others but by your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you."

Matthew 6:17-18
