#1	— — absence of passion, emotion, or excitement; lack of interest or concern (Rom 12:11).
#2	— — built on lies is good (John 8:44); built on truth is even better (Eph 4:27).
#3	— — those who always have to be "in the know" (1 Tim 5:13).
#4	— — the more trivial the subject, the better! (Phil 4:2-3)
#5	— — the brother or sister who is disheartened, exhausted, and empty (Gal 6:9).
#6	— — the result of a settlement between two or more parties (Rom 1:25; James 4:4)
#7	— — paying little or no attention to things that deserve great attention ( <i>Luke 11:42</i> ).
#8	— — deviation from accuracy, correctness, or soundness (1 John 4:6; 2 Pet 3:17)
#9	— — lack of knowledge, information, or education (Hos 4:6; Jer 5:30-31).
#1	<b>0</b> — selfish ambition, conceit, or self-importance ( <i>Phil 2:1-4</i> ).
