

# “I Will Make a New Covenant”

## INTRODUCTION:

- A. Your Creator wants to have a relationship with you. His revealed aim is:
1. To write his law on your heart.
  2. That you would know him as your God, and that you would be known as his redeemed child.
  3. To forgive your iniquities and remember your sins no more.
- B. He defines and describes this desired relationship with you in the language of a “covenant.”

## I. *Jeremiah 31:31-34* — “I Will Make a New Covenant”

- A. “Behold...” — God has something worthy of our \_\_\_\_\_.
- B. “...the days are coming” — in approximately 600 B.C., God was pointing to the \_\_\_\_\_.
- C. “...declares the LORD” — the source of this message is \_\_\_\_\_.
- D. “...when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah”
1. “...not like the covenant that I made with their fathers” — a new kind of \_\_\_\_\_.
  2. “...though I was their husband” — God takes covenants very \_\_\_\_\_.
  3. “I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts” — God wants \_\_\_\_\_ of you.
  4. “And I will be their God, and they shall be my people” — a \_\_\_\_\_ relationship.
  5. “I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more” — that’s \_\_\_\_\_ news!

## II. *Luke 22:7-20* — “The New Covenant in My Blood”

- A. “This is my body, which is given for you” — the language of an \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice.
- B. “This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.”
1. \_\_\_\_\_ had always been an element of God’s covenant with his people (*Exo 24:8*).
  2. God would establish a new covenant by the blood of his own \_\_\_\_\_ (*John 1:29*).

## III. *Hebrews 8-10* — “Now the Point in What We are Saying is This”

- A. “We have such a high priest” — on our own, we are \_\_\_\_\_ to approach God.
- B. “One who is seated at the right hand of the throne” — we serve a \_\_\_\_\_ Savior.

C. *“So Christ...will appear a second time”* — God takes covenants very \_\_\_\_\_.

D. *“Therefore, brothers”* — live the life of redeemed \_\_\_\_\_ of God.
