## Introduction:

	A <i>triad</i> is a group of three—especially of three closely related persons or things.  Faith, hope, and love are presented in the New Testament as a type of triad for the Christian.  1. "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen" (Heb 11:1,6).  - internal that leads to external
	2. "Hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees?" (Rom 8:24-25).  - confident that produces faith-filled
	3. "By this we know <b>love</b> , that he laid down his life for us" (1 John 3:16).  - self that seeks the good or the glory of
