I.	Elders come from men and women who, by the power of
	God, have been radically (John 3:3-6)
II.	Elders originate from Christians who are (Acts 4:4; 5:14; 8:12)
III.	Elders, by definition, are to be taken from among Christian men who are in years and in the faith. (1 Timothy 3:6)
IV.	Elders are drawn from mature Christian men who are (1 Timothy 3:2)
V.	Elders are to be taken from mature Christian men who are married and have (Titus 1:6; 1 Timothy 3:4)
VI.	From among mature Christian family men with many different abilities, there are bound to be some who are effective (1 Timothy 3:2)

A.	From all these qualifications of elders, there is nothing more significant as the fact that they are devoted
