- 3.) Following the way of this world will only kill me (Rom. 8:5-8; Gal. 5:16-17; John 14:6)
- 4.) Unlike my earthly relationships, God cannot fail me (Matt. 6:25-30; Heb.13:5; Ps.37:5-9, 12-13, 23-28)
- 5.) I need help, I need mercy (Rom. 7:19, 24; Phil.2:15; 1 Pet.2:10; 1 John 3:3)
- 6.) There is an inheritance for me (*Gal. 3:26-27; 1 Pet.1:3-5*)
- 7.) I can be saved forever (2 Cor.5:17; 1 John 5:12; Eph. 2:13)

B.) For the Sake of His Name

- 2.) Because of His great and Holy Name, I want to be a child of God (*Ps.68:20; 3:8; John 12:46; Rom.10:9; Acts 2:38*)
