- 3.) What Does Jesus Want? (Rev.3:14-19; Titus 2:13-14)

Looking to Jesus as We Mentor, Train, and Teach

- 1.) He took the opportunities around Him to teach his disciples patience, faith, and humility (Mark 4:10-13; Luke 17:3-5; John 13:12-15)
- 2.) Making certain that teaching is effective (Mark 4:34; 2 Tim. 3:10-12)
- 3.) Just as he did with His apostles, we are to take active roles in the lives of others (Titus 2:1-8)
- 4.) Jesus helped his disciples learn to deal with difficult situations (Matt.17:24-27; Gal. 6:1-2; John 2:14-17)
- 5.) He taught them to pray and he prayed and for them (Matt. 6:5-15; Acts 4:23-24; James 5:13-16; John 17:1, 6-10)

Jesus hand-picked the twelve to receive special attention and training; they went on to do the work of their master even after he was gone from this world. Christians should also invest their time and energy heavily in others. In this way, you can spread your zeal to future generations purposefully and powerfully.
