46—First Three Sayings Matthew 27:31-44; Mark 15:20-32; Luke 23:26-43

1. Before Jesus ever gets to the cross, what kind of suffering has He already faced beginning in the Garden of Gethsemane?

- 2. The walk to the cross is retold in the following passages (Matthew 27:31-37; Mark 15:20-27; Luke 23:26-31, 38; John 19:17-24). Who is compelled to carry the cross of Jesus (Mark 15:21; Romans 16:13)?
- 3. As Jesus walks toward the cross, what warning does He offer the crowd in Luke 23:28-31? What is the meaning of verse 31?



4. Every gospel writer mentions the inscription Pilate posts to the cross (Matthew 27:37; Mark 15:26; Luke 23:38; John 19:19-22). How did the Jews feel about this inscription? What did it say?

5. What is done with the clothes of Jesus (John 19:23-24)?

6. What kinds of things are being said to Jesus as He is upon the cross (Matthew 27:38-43; Mark 15:28-32; Luke 23:32-37; John 19:17-24)? What does Luke document Jesus said and why might this be remarkable (Luke 23:34)?
7. What is prophesied about Jesus in Isaiah 53:12? What did Jesus teach we must do to our enemies (Matthew 5:44)? What does Stephen do as he is martyred in Acts 7:60?
8. Who is crucified along with Jesus as He hangs upon the cross (Matthew 27:44; Luke 23:39-43)? Describe the exchange these two men have as they are crucified. What does Jesus say to one of the thieves and what does this mean (cp. Luke 16:19-31)?
9. Though many of the disciples forsook Jesus, who is still standing near Jesus as He is crucified (John 19:25; Mark 16:9; Luke 8:2; Mark 15:40; Matthew 27:56)? What do we know about these women?
10. What special role does Jesus give to John while upon the cross (John 19:26-27)? What kind of example should it set for us that Jesus was thinking of others though facing a great trial Himself?
