- 3. We begin to see things differently (1 Peter 1:14; 1 Thessalonians 4:5; Jeremiah 2:13)
- 4. We put away old desires and experience new ones (1 Peter 1:14)
- 5. We live as holy, ransomed exiles in confident fear (*1 Peter 1:15-25*)
