Introduction: A. Two accounts of two ships and two storms bad enough to worry experienced sailors
Bbut two storms that were ultimately calmed.
1. Example 1 — <i>Jonah 1:1-15</i>
2. Example 2 — Mark 6:30-52
C. The difference is in how the storms were calmed.
D. And that leads to the question: is my relationship with God such that the passengers are safe with me <i>on</i> the boat or <i>off</i> ?
