## We Are More Than Conquerors! (1)

(Romans 8:1-17)

**Scripture Reading:** *Galatians 5:16-26* 

- A. Think about where we have been most recently in our study of *Romans*.
  - 1. Romans 6 holiness is the logical calling for the Christian.
  - 2. Romans 7 in order to be justified in the sight of God, we must die to the law.
- B. Even as we recognize those truths, we are in desperate need of a deliverer (*Romans 7:21-24*).
- I. Romans 8:1-17 the logical result of life "in the Spirit" is life "according to the Spirit"
  - A. "The law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus..." (8:1-11)
    - 1. "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus" (8:1).
    - 2. "For God has done (by sending his own Son) what the law could not do" (8:3).
    - 3. "Those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh" (8:5).
    - 4. "You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit" (8:9).
  - B. "So then, brothers, we are debtors..." (8:12-17)
    - 1. "For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God" (8:14).
    - 2. "And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ" (8:17).
