Scripture Reading: John 15:12-17

- A. As disciples of Christ, we must grow to the point where we desire more than "just enough."
- B. Our very beings must long for **MORE** of everything God has to offer for our walk with Him.

I. The Role of John the Baptist

- A. He came to bear witness about the Light, that all might believe (*John 1:6-8*).
- B. In doing so, he attracted quite a bit of attention (*John 1:19-21*).
 - 1. "Are you the **Messiah**?"
 - 2. "Are you Elijah?"
 - 3. "Are you the Prophet?"
- C. John 1:22-23 do you think John was excited?
- D. John bears witness of the Christ (*John 1:29-34*).

II. The First Disciples of Jesus

- A. *John 1:35-39* do you think these men were excited?
- B. But for **Andrew** there was one thing he had to do "first" (John 1:41-42).
- C. **Philip** is willing to follow Jesus, but there is one thing he had to do **first** (*John 1:43-45*).
- D. Perhaps you can more easily relate to the reaction of **Nathanael** (*John 1:46-51*).

Conclusion:

- B. The question for you: do you have any sense of that excitement in your own discipleship?
