Having and Using Spiritual Perspective

Scripture Reading: Ecclesiastes 3:1-13

- A. **Perspective** from the Latin *prospectus*, meaning "distant view." It describes the ability to discern the relative importance of different objects and how they relate to one another.
- B. Good perspective is useful in a variety of ways.
 - 1. Visual perspective.
 - 2. **Situational** perspective.
 - 3. But what about *spiritual* perspective?
- I. Examples of people who lost the right perspective and became afraid or discouraged
 - A. **Moses** (*Exodus 3:11,13; 4:1,10*)
 - B. **Elijah** (1 Kings 19:9-18)
 - C. **Job** (*Job* 38-42:6)
 - D. Other examples abound Jonah, Judas, Ananias and Sapphira.
- II. What can we learn from the created beings of the spiritual realm?
 - A. **Demons** (*Mark 1:21-24; 3:10-11; 5:1-7; James 2:19*)
 - B. Angels (Luke 15; 1 Corinthians 10:13)
- III. What can we learn from those who have passed from this life?
 - A. The rich man and Lazarus (*Luke 16:19-31*)
 - B. So much will depend on our perspective! (Rom 14:10-12; Eccl 3:9-11; Heb 12:1-3)
