What About Abortion?

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 5:18-25

- A. On January 22, 1973, *Roe v. Wade* was decided by the United States Supreme Court. The Court ruled that a woman may abort her pregnancy for any reason, up until the "point at which the fetus becomes viable" "able to live outside the mother's womb."
- B. *Roe v. Wade* endures as one of the most controversial and politically significant cases in U.S. history. Since 1973, approximately 50 million abortions have been performed in this country.
- C. Clarifying our primary concern as God's people in 21st century America:
 - 1. Christ's church is not the pillar and support of societal politics (1 Timothy 3:15).
 - 2. God's kingdom is not of this world (*John 18:36; Philippians 3:20*).
 - 3. Murder is a moral issue, regardless of political or judicial attachment (*Rom 1:31; 2 Tim 3:3*).
- D. Abortion "kills the life of a baby after it has begun" (*Planned Parenthood* pamphlet, 1952).

- A. Children are precious blessings from the LORD (*Psalm 127:3-5; 128:3-4*)
- B. We are "fearfully and wonderfully made" by God (*Psalm 139:13-16*; *Jer 1:5*; *Isa 44:2*)
