• Congregation #2 is struggling with the tendency to quarrel with each other over matters of opinion (Rom 14:1-4, 10-13)
 Congregation #3 is arrogantly allowing sexual immorality that would make the most worldly unbeliever blush to go on unchecked among their membership (1 Cor 5:1-2)
• Congregation #4 is on the brink of deserting Jesus and the call of God's grace by turning to a different gospel (Gal 1:6-7)
 Congregation #5 has more than one overseer on the pathway to departure from the truth and leading the church into division (Acts 20:28-30)
• Congregation #6 has two female members whose struggle to get along has gotten so bad that they're being called out by name (Phil 4:2-3)
 Congregation #7 has members whose unwillingness to let go of human teachings is leading to what the apostle Paul would describe as "self-made religion" (Col 2:20-23)
Congregation #8 contains a number of brethren who would rather consistently mooch off the other members of the congregation than work (
 Congregation #9 has members who do not understand the things about which they are confidently speaking and are swerving away from sound doctrine (1 Tim 1:3-7)
 Congregation #10 has empty talkers and deceivers who need to be silenced because they are capsizing the faith of entire families in the church (Tit 1:10-14)
 Congregation #11 has a bully who is so fixated on "it's my way or the highway" that he has become a local church tyrant (3 John 9-10)
