 8. "...they will sanctify the Holy One of Jacob and will stand in **awe** of the God of Israel" (Isa 29:23)
 9. "It was a covenant of fear, and he feared me. He stood in **awe** of my name" (Mal 2:5)
 10. "...they glorified God and were filled with **awe**..." (Luke 5:26)
 11. "...they were filled with **awe** and said, 'Truly this was the Son of God!'" (Matt 27:54)
