## 17—Conversion of Saul of Tarsus Acts 9:1-31


- 1. Acts 1:8 predicts the gospel's progression starting in Jerusalem and spreading "to the end of the earth." In order to accomplish this mission, God still had one more person He would enlist—Saul of Tarsus. What does Acts 9:15-16 tell us about the mission God had for Saul?

4. What happens as Saul travels towards Damascus (Acts 9:3-9)? Who appears to him (9:5; 1 Corinthians 9:1; 15:8-9)?

5. Was Saul "saved" on the road to Damascus? Is he acting like a saved man (Acts 9:9)?

6. Who else does the Lord speak to in this passage (Acts 9:10)? What mission does he have for this individual and what was the initial reaction of this disciple to the mission God gives him (Acts 9:11-16)?
7. What further instructions is Saul given once Ananias finds him (Acts 9:17-19; cp. Acts 22:16)? NOW is he acting like a saved man (Acts 9:18-19)?
8. It is amazing how God can take a man full of zeal and leadership skills, though misdirected, and turn those abilities into assets for the church. What do the following passages indicate about Saul after his conversion? What does he teach us about true conversion?
